Whitefish Point Lighthouse and Great Lakes **Shipwreck Museum** – Come learn about the perils of maritime transport on the Great Lakes at the Whitefish Point Light Station, a site on the National Register of Historic Places. Whitefish Point Light, which has been in continuous operation since 1861, is the oldest operating lighthouse on Lake Superior. The area is also a great place to find Yooperlite rocks! (Paradise)
